John Wright combines modern high-quality finishes with the strength and traditional look and feel of cast iron. Shelf brackets provide a beautiful upscale alternative to low-cost steel brackets.

- Sold individually or in pairs (check catalog for each part number)
- Matched screws are included
- Material: all are cast iron except for 35-030 which is cast aluminum
- Finish: see chart below
- Warranty: 1-year replacement; indoor brackets carry no warranty against corrosion

Installation

- 1. Position shelf bracket in its desired location. Brackets may be used in either orientation. Mark the position of the two screw holes.
- 2. Drill pilot holes and install the bracket using only the longer pair of screws. Do not use shorter screws to attach bracket to mounting surface as strength may be compromised. For weight-bearing (non-decorative) use, mount the bracket only to a solid wood surface that is structurally sound. Safe mounting on any other surface will require use of special screw or anchors (not included). If you intend for a shelf to hold more than 100 pounds or 45 kilograms, please contact John Wright in advance.
- 3. Position the other bracket so that it is level with the first and spaced for your shelf. Install it in the same way as the first bracket.
- 4. Position the shelf on top of the brackets and center it. Mark the position of the screw holes on each bracket. Carefully drill pilot holes so as to not go through the shelf. If using thin shelving, make sure that the shorter screws will not be too long. Attach the shelf to the brackets using two shorter screws per bracket. For safety, brackets must only be used with a shelf that is attached as described.
